Requests

We use *could you* ... and *would you* ... as polite ways of **telling or asking someone to do something**:

Could you open the door, please?
Would you carry this for me, please?

can and will are less polite:

Can you open the door, please?
Will you carry this for me, please?

Offers

We use *can I* ... to make offers:

Can I help you?
Can I do that for you?

We can also use **shall I** ...:

Shall I help you with that?
Shall I call you on your mobile?

Invitation

We use would you like (to) ... for invitations:

Would you like to come round tomorrow? Would you like another drink?

How to Reply to an Invitation

قبول الدعوة Accept

That sounds good/great/wonderful.

That'd be nice.

I'd love to.

رفض الدعوة Decline /reject

Thank you for the kind invitation ,regretfully I won't be able to make it due to...

Sounds like great fun, but I'm afraid I have...

I'm afraid we'll be-ing that day

Thanks for thinking of me. But unfortunately...

Questions to Start Conversations

Here are some ideas that are often used to make small talk (informal conversation about everyday things):

عمل او وظيفة A-Job

- -Tell me about your current job
- -How did you start working in your occupation?
- -What do you do?
- -How long have you worked there?
- -What do you do outside work to unwind/relax?
- -How do you usually start the day?

الطقس B-Weather

-What's the temperature today?

- -Such beautiful weather today, isn't it?
- -It's hot/cold outside.
- -It's warm and sunny outside.
- -We couldn't ask for better weather.
- -I think it's going to rain later.

الطعام C-Food

- -Have you tried this food before?
- **-**What is your favorite food/meal?
- -Is your country famous for any foods?
- -What restaurants do you like to go to?
- -Do you like to eat fast food?
- -Have you ever tried sea food?

D-People's Interests اهتمامات الأشخاص

- -Have you seen any good films recently?
- -What's the best gift you've ever gotten?
- -Do you like travelling?
- -What is your favorite hobby?
- -If you had all the money in the world, what would you do with it?
- -Who is your favorite singer?
- -Do you have any pets?

E-Where you are:(the room, the people,the view,..)

- -Do you know anyone here?
- -She is from Iraq, isn't she?
- -How long have you been living in London?
- -They look happy, don't they?
- -Do you think she'll like my gift?
- -The car looks clean, isn't it?
- -Have you ever been to the sea?
